I did reach out to the county freeholders and there are no programs for any relief from the county. I did speak with Carolyn about the cable also -- she did eliminate cable entirely and purchased a digital antenna for about \$45. I recommend we test this for Ptak, if it works with either funding from the Housing Authority or fund raising; these be purchased for all of Ptak. Further discussion/research needs to be done on this. **Renee** Mayor O'Neil has reached out to Assemblyman Robert Clifton, (works with Comcast) and he will get back to us regarding Comcast.
