-The resident surveys were due March 14th, we will bring in and share the results.

-There has been a raccoon(s) sighting. The feeding of the stray cats may cause them to come around. John Hazen took a call from the Department of Health. A memo was read from John Hazen informing tenants on a conversation with the Department of Health and Environmental Protection and the NJ Division of Fish and Wildlife and they first advised the residents to stop leaving food for any and all animals.

-We want to talk about whether the board would consider using a plot of land for the residents to plant a vegetable garden. It is a project that could be positive - sense of community. We will wait for a proposal from the organization that may have money left over (they grew the raised garden at St. Marks).
